TCCRI will host an Education Policy Summit in Austin featuring statewide officials, legislators, and private sector experts. The event will feature a keynote with Acting Comptroller Kelly Hancock, who will discuss implementation of the school choice legislation enacted by the Legislature.

This will be followed by two panel discussions, the first of which will be focused on school choice and accountability. The panel will discuss Texas' new Education Freedom Accounts and the public-school accountability system reforms enacted in 2025.

The second panel will discuss innovation in public education and the ways to ensure that from school safety to virtual learning, the best technologies are accessible to all school districts, students, and parents in Texas.

Elected officials will be joined by private sector experts and stakeholders during both panel discussions.
